- Evaluating current policy implementation or community transformations to enable us to estimate impact of interventions
- Opportunities linking exiting cohort studies –
 ALSPAC
- Embedding inequalities on all HITs/CLAHRC West projects



Person centred care: from vision to reality

- To investigate whether factors that support person centered care (e.g. continuity of care, relationships, caring for staff) lead to cost savings within a reasonable payback time.
- To conduct an evidence review on effective communication of research evidence into accessible information for patients/public.
- To explore different electronic methods for patient held information which all systems can read.



Healthy neighbourhoods

- Road closures connecting community/hearing children play
- Environmental cells transport quadrants
- 5 ways wellbeing community campaign
- Engaging young people using outdoor spaces
- Impact of lack of rural transport on health



Improving well-being for people with long term conditions

- Holistic care for patients with multiple LTCs
- Better communication between sectors of care provision (1' & 2'; between specialists)
- How and when to access care
- Interventions to improve self-management
- Evaluate the 'House of Care' model

- Involve patient and carers expertise in treatment decisions



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
