Stroke HIT Peer Director - FAQs



1. How long is the role for?

Two years

2. Where are meetings normally held?

Meetings are generally held at venues across Bristol.

3. How much will I get paid?

We pay an hourly rate of £21.15. This is for the duration of meetings attended - people are expected to read the papers for meetings beforehand - this preparation time is not paid in addition to the meeting time, but is included in the rate.

If peer directors are asked to do specific pieces of work outside of meetings, there may be payment for this, but must be negotiated in advance and is at the discretion of the Stroke HIT directors.
