
## Who we are and what we do

#### Bristol Health Partners

We are **Bristol Health Partners**. We are a group of organisations who work together and use **research** to make health and care services in **our area** better for everyone.



**Research** is when people think about problems and find ways to fix them. Research finds new and exciting knowledge.



Our area is Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire (called BNSSG for short)



We want to talk to lots of different people and listen to their ideas. We want to make sure there is **equality**, **diversity** and **inclusion** in health and care services in BNSSG.

## Equality, diversity and inclusion









### Equality

**Equality** means everyone is treated in a **fair** way. **Fair** is when everyone has what they need in life.

### **Diversity**

**Diversity** means differences. It means including people who have **protected characteristics**.

**Protected characteristics** are some things about you that make you who you are.

If you have protected characteristics you might not get treated the same way as other people. This is called **discrimination**.

There are lots of protected characteristics like age, gender, religion, disability, background and culture.

### Inclusion

**Inclusion** means including everyone. It means people with protected characteristics are not left out.

# What we will do to make health and care services better for everyone









We will

- talk to lots of different people and listen to their ideas
- include people with protected characteristics when we talk to people and listen to their ideas
- think about the needs of everyone in BNSSG
- talk to people who haven't helped us with our work before
- pay people who give their time to help us
- make sure there is equality, diversity and inclusion at organisations we work with
- make sure there is equality, diversity and inclusion in everything we do.



Team

We will make sure the research we do looks at lots of different people and includes people with protected characteristics.

### **Health Integration Teams**

We will ask our **Health Integration Teams** (called **HITs** for short) to help us with our work.

HITs are groups of people from universities, health organisations and people who use health and care services.

HITs have lots of ideas about how to make health and care services better for everyone.
